

Duties and Responsibilities

The responsibilities of the Youth Pastor shall include the following:

- Provide oversight of CLAY (Youth, 13-19 yrs) and Young Adult (20-35 yrs) programs, Bible classes, CGs, events.
- Be acquainted with the personal lives of the young people.
- Foster communication with parents of youth.
- Equip and train youth/YA in areas such as how to study and lead a Bible study, how to do personal evangelism, how to lead a small group, how to be sensitive to the Holy Spirit, etc.
- Plan and execute programs, events, mission trips, and camps for youth/YA that would facilitate their spiritual growth and broaden their perspective on life.
- Help the young people gain a “Kingdom perspective” and be able to identify their role in building God’s kingdom.
- Provide support, assistance, and guidance to youth/YA leaders as required.
- Disciple youth/YA with leadership potential.
- Evaluate and make recommendations concerning teaching materials and methods used in youth/YA ministries.
- Discern and select conferences/talks (outside church) that are beneficial for our young people to attend and encourage them to do so.
- Participate in Sunday worship services.
- Preach in Sunday worship services when requested/rostered.
- Attend other events of the church as time allows.
- Attend denominational gatherings/events (where relevant).
- Participate in inter-church Youth Pastor gatherings (as time permits)
